ARAB 101	ARABIC MORPHOLOGY 1	ARAB 101 introduces students to the concepts of Arabic morphology (sarf), focusing on verb conjugation and patterns. Emphasis will be placed on understanding root letters and their derivatives.	4
ARAB 102	ARABIC SYNTAX 1	Students study the basics of Arabic syntax (nahw), covering essential grammatical structures and sentence formation, building the ability to construct and comprehend Arabic words and sentences.	4
ARAB 131	ARABIC COMPREHENSION AND ANALYSIS 1	This course introduces students to classical Arabic texts, emphasizing reading comprehension and linguistic analysis skills.	2
ARAB 121	ARABIC LITERATURE / CONVERSATION 1	Combining literature with conversational practice, this course aims to improve both reading and speaking skills. Students will engage with texts and discussions to enhance fluency and confidence in spoken Arabic.	3
HADT 101	HADITH GRAMMAR AND ANALYSIS 1	Focused on the linguistic aspects of hadith, this course examines the grammar and structure of prophetic traditions. Students will memorize, analyze and interpret hadith texts with grammatical precision.	2
FOUN 101	VOCALIZATION 1	This course introduces the principles of Arabic vocalization (tajweed), teaching the correct pronunciation of letters and words. Emphasis will be placed on mastering proper pronunciations.	1
FIQH 101	JURISPRUDENCE 1	Students will be introduced to the subject of Islamic Jurisprudence, key terms, and an overview of the schools of Fiqh, their guiding principles, and their founders.	1
TAKR 101	Takrār/Mutāl'a 1	Students will be given supervised in-class time to complete assignments, study, ask questions, and complete revisions.	6

ARAB 132	ARABIC COMPREHENSION AND ANALYSIS 2	This course introduces students to classical Arabic literature, emphasizing reading comprehension and linguistic analysis skills.	2
